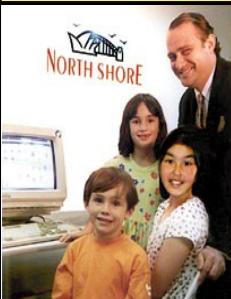

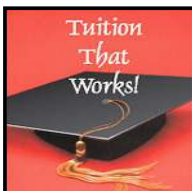
Yirou Ng (Gifted & Talented Winner)

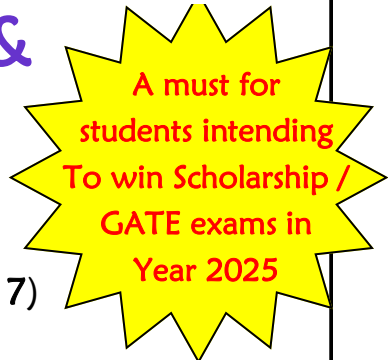

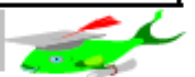
