Development of problem solving and critical thinking skills are key themes that are intertwined into our learning programs. Not only are these important skills to equip our students to be well prepared for any high-stakes exams (such as Opportunity Class Placement Test or Selective School Placement Test) or any assessment task they may encounter during their schooling, but they are important lifelong skills to being well prepared as individuals for their future careers. A strong foundation in these key skills coupled with a good learning ethic is what we try to foster in students attending our Colleges to provide them with the best opportunity to thrive.

As part of our commitment to ongoing curriculum rejuvenation and enhancement to ensure we have leading-edge, relevant and effective learning programs for our students, we will be launching MyStudy - North Shore Coaching College's Digital Learning Platform, which allows students to complete some learning tasks online as part of their weekly study. Our educators can also pinpoint potential areas for further intervention, focus and reinforcement. MyStudy will first be rolled out to our Year 3 and 4 Maths and Thinking Skills programs to integrate a component of homework to be completed at home online on a weekly basis (Digital Homework) and a Pre-Term test which will provide students with an opportunity to revise and prepare ahead of the end of term test. All questions can be re-attempted and reviewed online. We do not expect students to spend an excessive amount of time online with these tasks as this could be a potential concern for parents. However, it is important to provide students with a regular experience to complete learning activities in digital format in a controlled manner to build their skills and confidence to do so when required in their studies and examinations here and in schools. The importance of being prepared for both pen and paper tasks as well as tasks in digital format cannot be underestimated. We will also be introducing MyStudy to other levels moving forward as we continue to further improve/enhance the learning platform.

Additionally, for students in Years 3 and 4 who join our Term 4 program, we will be providing a **free Problem Solving Assessment in Term 4**. This assessment will analyse problem solving behaviour and ability, develop, remediate and extend problem solving skills, and further our educational research which started with the Assessment Research Centre of The University of Melbourne over 20 years ago.

**Encourage Curiosity:** Encourage a student to ask questions, explore ideas and seek answers. This will help them to develop an inquisitive mindset and a thirst for knowledge.

Challenge Assumptions: Encourage a student to challenge assumptions and think outside the box. This will help them to develop a critical mindset and consider alternative perspectives.

Analyse Information: Teach a student how to analyse information, evaluate evidence and draw logical conclusions. This helps develop strong analytical and problem-solving skills.

Encourage Creativity: Encourage a student to use their imagination and come up with innovative ideas. This will help them to develop a unique perspective and approach problems in a novel way.

**Practise Reflection:** Encourage a student to reflect on their thoughts and actions and to consider alternative viewpoints. This helps them to develop self-awareness and to understand the impact of their decisions.




